1. Introduction and Executive Summary (Page 1-5)

Explanation:

2. Community Engagement (Page 6-10)

Explanation:

The county took a ***comprehensive approach** to gather feedback by using multiple engagement methods. These included:

- **Public Meetings:** Open forums where residents could voice their opinions, concerns, and suggestions about key issues facing the county. These meetings provided opportunities for direct interaction between the public and county officials.
- **Workshops:** Specialized workshops focused on specific topics such as transportation, infrastructure, housing, and economic development. These allowed for in-depth discussions and brainstorming with stakeholders and experts in each area.
- **Surveys:** To ensure broader participation, the county conducted surveys to reach residents who might not attend in-person meetings.
